



Magdeburg is located in the heart of Germany – perfectly accessible from all directions. Whether by train, car, or plane, the "Ottostadt" is well-connected and easy to reach.

By Train

Magdeburg is excellently connected by rail, with direct train services from Berlin, Hanover, Leipzig, and many other cities. Thanks to its central location, you can reach

Saxony-Anhalt's capital quickly and comfortably.

Regular train connections also run directly from the surrounding airports to Magdeburg.

By Car

The Magdeburg motorway junction ensures excellent accessibility:

- A2 towards Hanover and Berlin
- A14 towards Leipzig and Dresden
- In addition, several federal roads (B1, B71, B81, B184, B189, B246)
- lead directly into or around the city perfect for flexible travel by car or coach.

By Plane

Three international airports are located nearby and offer direct train connections to Magdeburg:

- Berlin Brandenburg (BER) approx. 130 km
- Hannover Airport approx. 130 km
- Leipzig/Halle Airport approx. 100 km

This makes Magdeburg easily accessible from all over Europe – centrally located, well-connected, and ready to welcome you warmly!





\delta Financial Report – EPOA AGM 2026 Magdeburg

The EPOA Annual General Meeting 2026 in Magdeburg will be built on a clear vision: to host an event that is financially solid, socially fair, and accessible to everyone. Our goal is not only to balance numbers – but to make sure that participation is possible for all, regardless of financial background.

Estimated Budget

Total Income: approx. €115,000

Total Expenditure: approx. €115,000

A responsible and transparent financial plan ensures that every euro directly supports the event, the participants, and the community.

Income

• ■ Delegate Fees: €60,000 (tiered pricing to make participation affordable for everyone)

 ♦ Additional Income: €10,000 (solidarity donations, merchandise, and community fundraising)

Expenditure

- Accommodation & Catering: €52,000
 (comfortable hotels, regional and sustainable food options)
- m Conference & Venue Costs: €16,000 (venues, technical equipment, translation, and accessibility)
- Solidarity Fund: €12,000 (travel and participation support for delegates with limited resources)

Solidarity & Sustainability

The Solidarity Fund (€12,000) is at the heart of our financial approach. It ensures that financial limitations never become a barrier to participation. Grants of up to €1,000 will be available for delegates from financially weaker regions, especially from Central and Eastern Europe.

Sustainability is another key pillar:


- Cooperation with local suppliers and regional partners
- Environmentally friendly catering and logistics
- Use of existing city infrastructure and public transport
- Full transparency in all financial processes

Any remaining surplus will be reinvested into the CSD Saxony-Anhalt Solidarity Fund, supporting queer initiatives across the state.
